

Did you know that the Saguaro cactus is a “protected” plant, specifically in the State of Arizona? If you have a Saguaro that you would like to have removed from your yard, here are a few “guidelines” to follow:

- If the Saguaro is healthy (salvageable with no bird holes), you will need to contact a cactus removal company. The removal company will work with the AZ Department of Agriculture to secure a removal tag, and obtain all necessary permits. This removal is free of charge.
